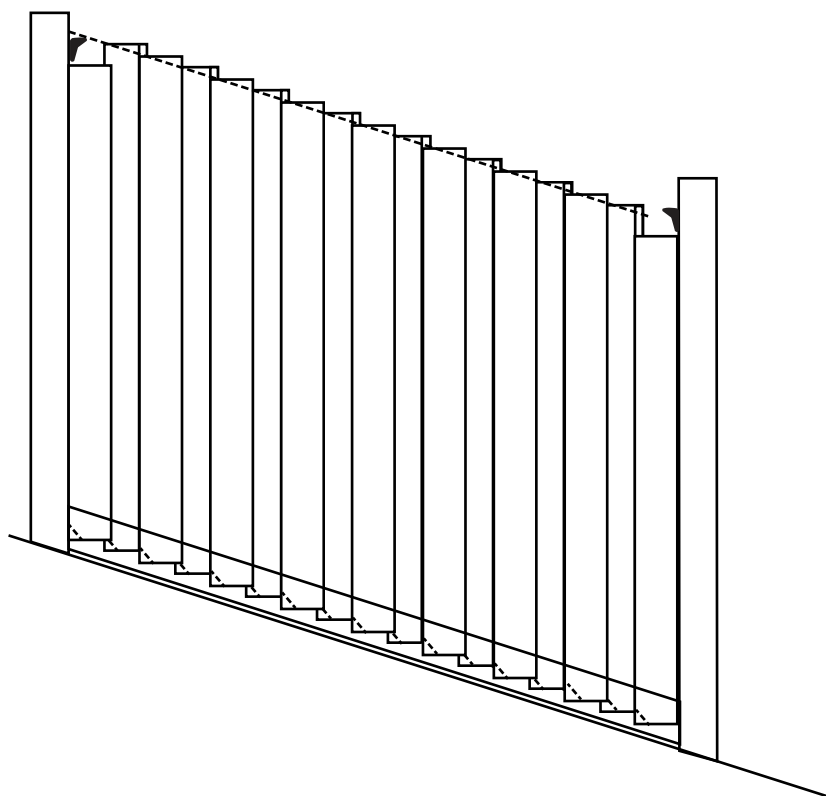


If grade is over 22°, or drops over 20" in 4', then it will be necessary to cut the bottom of the pickets at an angle so that the picket does not stick out of the bottom rail. If the grade is over 32°, or drops over 29" in 4', then it will also be necessary to cut the top of the pickets at an angle so that the picket does not stick out of the top rail.



For transitions, you need to cut your pickets at an angle. This is easily done by assembling the pickets and then chalking a line so you can cut them with a circular saw.
